

**Caton CPS receives £16,380 of PE & Sport Funding for the academic year 2018/19.**

<b>Planned developments</b>	<b>Cost</b>
1. To provide additional provision for swimming over and above the national curriculum requirements. KS1, Reception and lower KS2 to swim weekly for 12 weeks.	£2000
2. To further improve PE provision and training for staff in a variety of sports e.g. dance, gymnastics, netball, athletics. <b>Improvements will be sustainable through staff observing professional coaches role modelling, participating in the sessions and receiving advice from the professional coaches.</b>	£1527
3. Membership of Schools Sports Partnership which includes: coaching for variety of sports within the local area, entry into team competitions, curriculum support for sports development, opportunities for development of key groups e.g. more girls participating in team sports. <b>As above, staff will be upskilled through observation and participation in coaching sessions led by professional coaches.</b>	£2400
4. Continue to enhance opportunities for children to take part in a variety of enrichment activities including forest sessions and outdoor adventurous activities. <b>As above, staff will be upskilled through observation and participation in coaching sessions led by professional coaches.</b>	£1500
5. Encourage increased physical activity during pupils' free time through development of outdoor areas, purchase of equipment, introduction of the 'Mile a Day' initiative and additional staffing.	£3500
6. Provide pupils with access to a wider range of sports such as golf and fencing.	£700
7. Transport to annual sports day	£240
