Maths: Y2/3 have started their work on statistics with tally charts. This week they surveyed the school to find the most popular colour and pet. Next week they will turn these results into pictograms. Y4/5/6 will learn about area and perimeter.

English: Year 4/5/6 wrote their own kenning poems last week as part of world poetry day - have a look out for them on display around school. This week Y3 are writing their own fables; Y4/5/6 - Working on biography writing.

Science: We have been learning a lot about plants and their life cycles. This week we will be learning about how people use plants around the world.

This week we will investigate the animals and plants that live in rainforests and the resources that come from rainforests. Year 4/5/6 will also learn about fair trade.
