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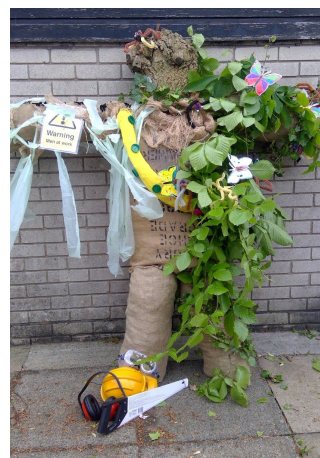
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WELCOME BACK

Class 1

Maths: We are learning about multiplication and division first of all this term, starting with our 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

English: Building up to writing an adventure story, we have been talking about Superheroes this week and next week we will be carrying this on, using plenty of adjectives to describe our adventures. We have started our new novel - Wind in the Willows. Storytime will resume on Thursday - please can I ask that all parents enter through the front door and sign in and that we do not leave the side door open in the interests of keeping the children safe - thank you in advance.

Topic: Our topic is 'How does our Garden Grow?' and to start the topic off we will be looking at what grows in our own school grounds. We will also be having an afternoon of 'Forest Schools', led by a specialist teacher on Thursday.

PE: Throwing and sprinting in our Athletics unit next week.

RE: Next week we will begin our unit on Christianity, thinking about how and why celebrating is important. We will be thinking about all the different ways we celebrate.

Music: Our unit is based on a reggae style song called Zootime. Next week, we will be investigating the pulse or beat in the song.

Computing: Sound is our theme in this half term's computing sessions and using the iPads, we will be recording sound and considering how we can improve the quality.
