HEALTHY EATING

Our school nurse, Liz Atkinson, came into school on Thursday to talk to our children about the importance of healthy eating. She showed them what a healthy packed lunch looks like and explained that a sweet snack and crisps in a lunchbox every day is not advisable. This could be replaced with e.g. carrot or celery sticks and hummus, fruit or yoghurt. She also explained how sugary drinks such as Capri Sun and Fruit Shoots would be better replaced with weaker sugar-free squash.
