### ODD SOCK 'BE A FRIENDSHIP HERO' DAY - Tuesday 12th November

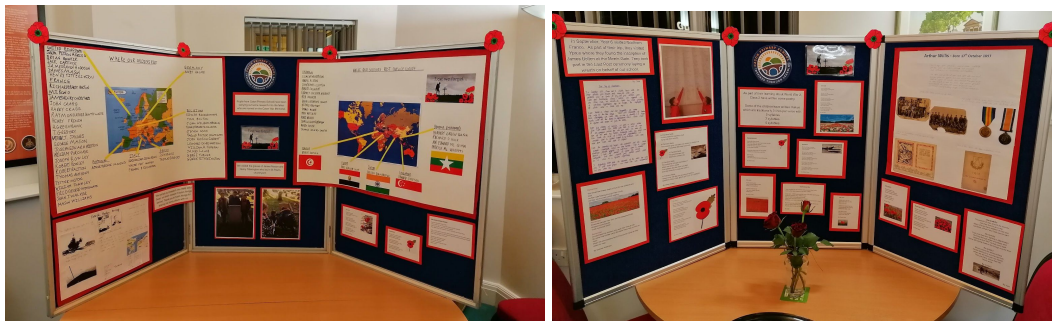
