### A MESSAGE FROM B4RN

Do you want access to [gold standard](#) hyper fast (IGb) fibre broadband for yourself, or have it available for your children as they grow up?

Caton Primary School already have this installed.

We have an opportunity to get this installed in the village soon BUT for it to happen we need people to sign up.

This is very much a "last chance". If this project does not happen now it is unlikely B4RN will install it in the future.

The sign-up form is here; <https://b4rn.org.uk/postcode-checker/>  
Enter your postcode, read the information, and then fill in the Gigabyte voucher request form. At this stage there is NO obligation to take the service (even though the form implies this) and we need everyone to fill it in to make it happen. Once correctly completed an email confirmation will be received.

A B4RN connection costs £30/month. It is hyper fast and unlimited! The 12-month contract stated on the form is not binding as B4RN do not charge for leaving.

PLEASE, help us get this future proof, hyper fast, reliable broadband installed for now and the future.
