

Non Negotiable	<p>Autumn - The weather gets cooler after summer. The autumn months are September, October and November. The amount of daylight hours reduces.</p> <p>Winter - This is the coolest season.</p>			<p>The days are longer in the summer.</p> <p>The days are shorter in the winter.</p> <p>The weather changes through the year.</p> <p>The Earth tilts (leans) towards the sun in the summer.</p> <p>The Earth tilts (leans) away from the sun in the winter</p> <p>Some trees remain green in all four seasons. These trees are called evergreen trees.</p>
Greater Depth	<p>We call the general weather trends and the extremes of weather in one place a 'climate'</p> <p>There are five different classifications of climate: polar, cold, temperate, dry and tropical. The UK has what is called a 'temperate' climate. A temperate climate is one that is not too extreme.</p>
