All full time remote learners will receive a telephone call on Tuesday afternoon from Miss van Mierlo or Miss Houseman.

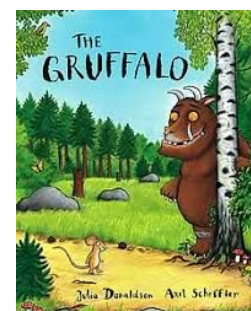
