Dear Parents/Guardians

Now that the weather is warming up, we would like to clarify our policy on the use of sunscreen.

Parents are encouraged to apply, or get their child to apply, a long-lasting sunscreen before school and to come to school with a hat. We also ask that parents provide a clearly labelled (named) supply of suncream to be kept in school through the summer months, in case it needs to be reapplied during the day. Please note that this is only in case of the need to top up and on sunny days, it is expected that children arrive at school with sunscreen already applied.

Normally, pupils will be encouraged to apply their own sunscreen under the supervision of an adult, however this may not always be possible for younger pupils or those with special needs or a physical disability. Appropriately vetted adults may help pupils apply sunscreen to their face, neck, and arms when another adult is present. Pupils should always apply sunscreen to their own legs.
