## First Aid training



On Tuesday, every child in the school received their first aid training. They were taught what to do in a range of emergency situations from performing CPR to dressing burns and how to help someone if they are choking.

Today, four of our pupils represented our school by attending the Pupil Parliament event at Lancaster House Hotel, accompanied by Mrs Taylor, one of our school Governors. There were representatives from many of the schools in our area and the event was organised by the LCC Equality and Diversity Team. The children did a range of activities looking at protected characteristics of Sex and Gender in the Equality Act 2010. They took part in workshops discussing Sex and Gender stereotypes, Equality in Careers & Pay and looking at Identity. They discussed Stereotypes and how they can affect our perceptions of people and the jobs they do. They did a fun Dance workshop where they worked in groups taking it in turns to come up with a move that was then combined to make a short routine that they performed to music. There was also a workshop on how toys are advertised and aimed at specific genders and whether the colour of an item should limit who can buy or play with them. Our pupils represented the school and its values beautifully and their pride in attending Caton Primary School shone through. Their contributions throughout were thoughtful and thought provoking. Well done to George, Harris, Harrison and Hollie for representing our school so admirably and a big thank you to Mrs Taylor for accompanying the children.
