### Uniform

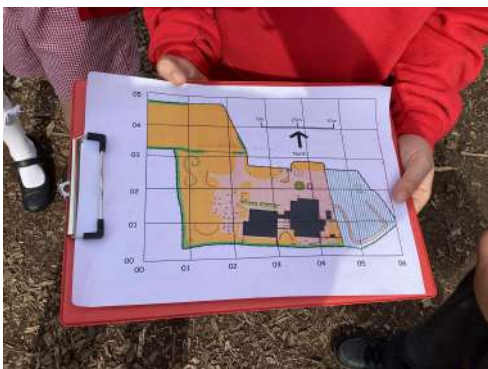
