Wednesday/Thursday: Drama Club: Joseph cast - by invite only

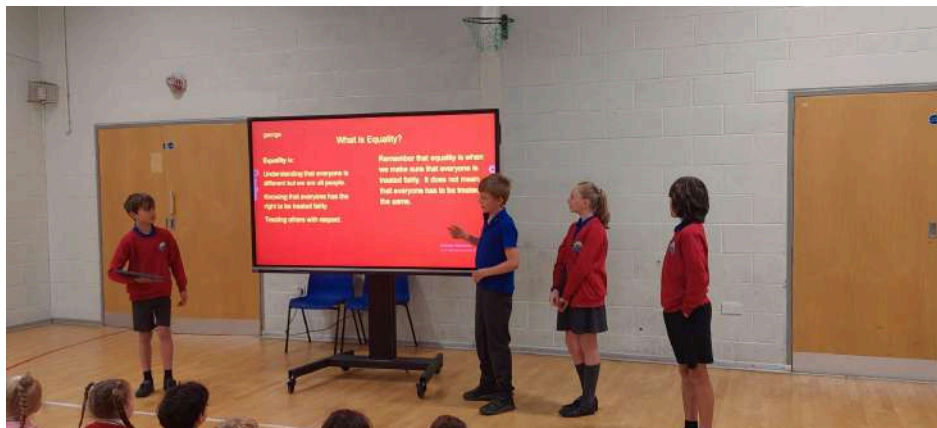
