outstanding turnout, the votes were counted. Congratulations to the Bright Party, who gained a majority and formed our school government!



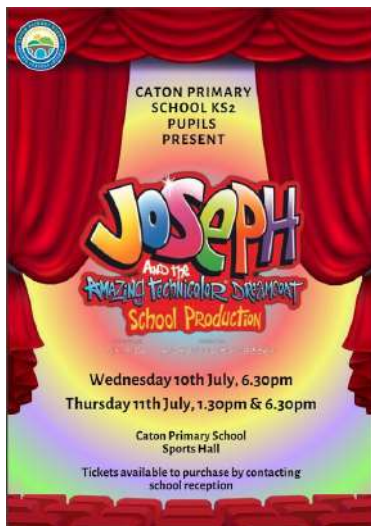

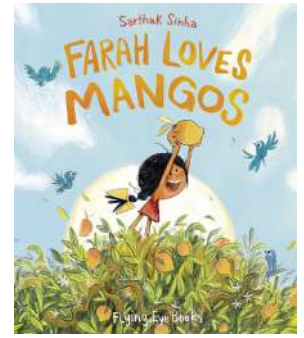

Brilliant Books to Read

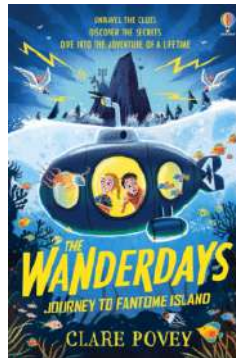
Farah Loves Mangos by Sarthak Sinha
