50th Anniversary and Open Day Celebration - Saturday 5th October 10:30am - 1:30pm

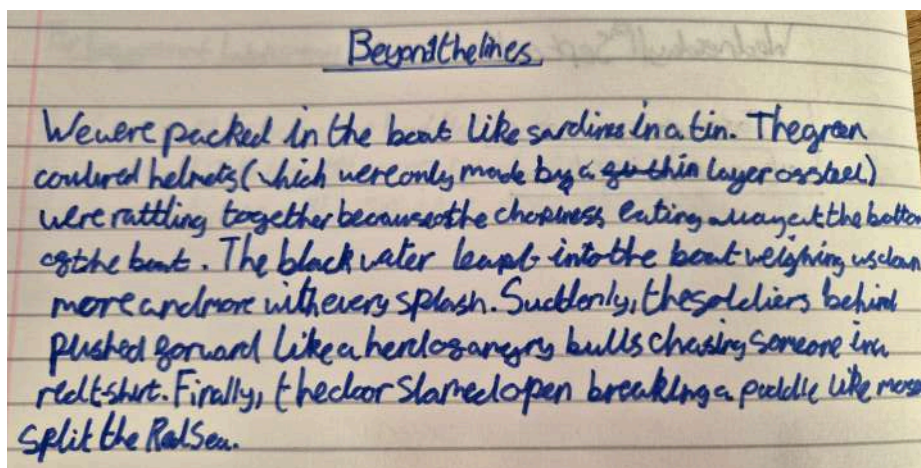

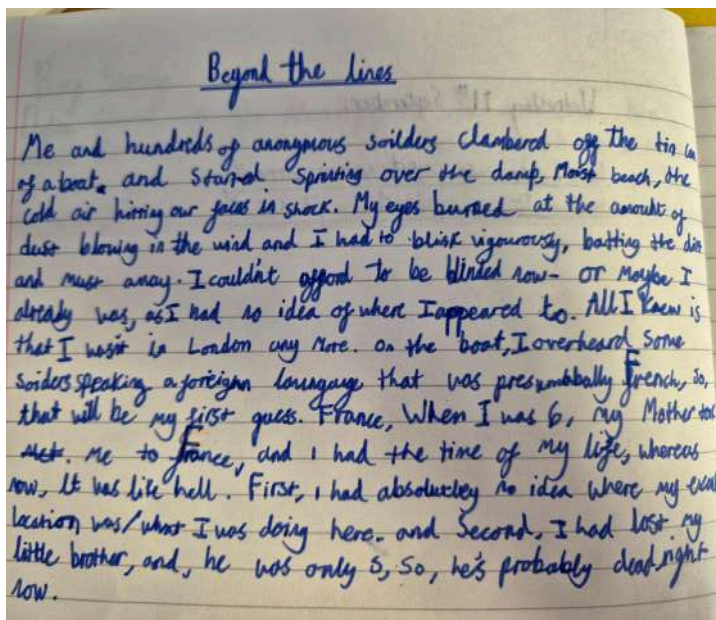

Time: 8:00 PM

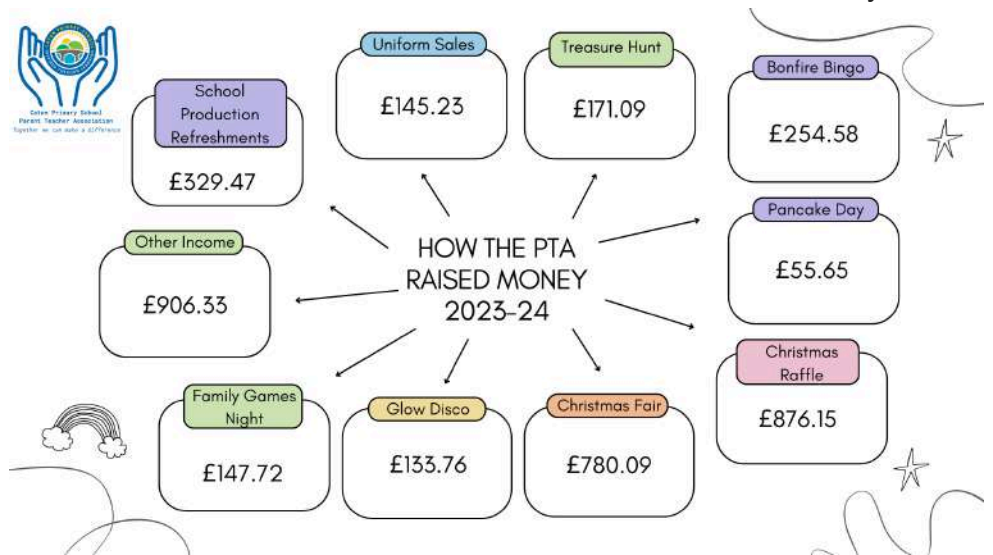
Venue: The Station Pub, Caton
