


Class 4 learning update



Class 4's penultimate science lesson on light saw them testing the manner in which light travels. They conducted two short investigations to either prove or disprove that light can only travel in straight lines. They used torches, lasers, mirrors, and pinhole cardboard pieces to prove that light cannot bend in a curved line and then summarised their findings.

Class 4 have also been working hard to develop their sketching skills, using every spare minute to improve their use of 'continuous line drawing'. They have improved brilliantly over the last few weeks and have enjoyed putting pencil (or pen) to paper in their sketchbooks.
